Change is not always easy yet I believe it can be refreshing. In order to continue improvements around the Club, effective April 1st we will be implementing the following increase and additions to our dues and fees structure:

- Initiation Fee increase from \$1000.00 to \$2500.00

- A Non-Resident Food minimum of \$30.00 per month will be implemented, this will be an annual minimum due to be met by December 31st of each year. 2024 minimum will be prorated for the 9 remaining months, \$270.00.
- An 18% service charge will be added to each member and guest charge in food and beverage. This will allow Mimosa Hills to provide our Food and Beverage associates locally competitive wages.

From Your Golf Course superintendent

March-April 2024 Newsletter – Golf Course – Dan Winters, GCS

Let's hope the El Nino cycle ends for this spring. January/February saw just over 10" of rain. The spring pre-emerge weed control application was completed in February. As well, we got started early on the bermudagrass aerification process this year. Perhaps finished by March 1. The greens will be solid tine (5/16" diameter) aerified and double verti-cut sometime in March. After a rolling the disruption to ball roll will be a minimum.

We cut down some dead and dying trees this past winter. The 2 oak trees removed at #11 green's approach will allow us to establish some healthy bermudagrass, one of our main eyesores on the golf course. Over time we will keep trying to remove the unsightly and dangerous white pines. Removing the cluster right side landing area on #7 will help grow healthier grass.

We continue to add sand to bunkers in need. It seems we have favorable comments on the new G-Angle bunker sand we were forced to go to after the SP-55 (Spruce Pine) sand was no longer available. The new sand does not have the bright white color.

The 5 Deodar Cedar trees installed between the driving range and #10 look great. This improvement can be credited to the efforts of the Mimosa Hills Preservation Donors Club. Thank you to all who support that program. Soon we will promote upcoming plans.

The topic of converting our 21 year old A4 bentgrass greens came up at the Annual Meeting in January. Many good questions were asked and I tried my best to answer them briefly. Over the years, CGA Agronomist Bill Anderson visited the golf course with the presence of Board members and Staff. Detailed reports followed each visit. Switching to ultradwarf bermudagrass (UDB) was covered every year discussing the benefits. There are newer varieties of bentgrass out there but Bill's recommendation was that if we went that route a complete green's construction from drainage on up would be warranted. This would add to the cost greatly verses a re-surfacing with UDB.

A rough estimate of \$400,000 to \$500,000 was stated at the meeting. Some variables like doing the bunker slopes in zoysiagrass would bring costs to the higher number. Zoysiagrass would reduce bunker slope mowing labor greatly over the years with the end result being the golf ball releasing into the sand. The par 3 tees would be leveled and re-surfaced with a new tee variety bermudagrass. If construction began in early June the golf course could open by September 1 or sooner. When I mentioned 8 weeks at the meeting that referred to once the UDB sprigs were layed out then grown in. We need a few weeks for the stripping of the old grass and adding the sand, peat and amendment green's mix.

Hopefully March/April will bring some great spring time golfing weather!












